SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY

Care & Independence is a British manufacturer with two production sites in the UK. Tier-1 supply-chain partners are also UK-based, meaning we are well positioned to avoid lengthy lead times and possible disruption to supply compared to importers. Operating a multi-vendor sourcing policy further mitigates the risk of interruption to materials inflow.

Additionally, with a number of logistics options at our disposal (including consignment stocking and call-off options amongst other potential commercial arrangements), this further helps to secure the goods supply chain to customers.



FABRIC & MATERIALS

Care & Independence products are manufactured using a range of high quality fabrics and materials. Each component is selected from the most appropriate materials to optimise performance and product life span. Fabric compatibility, stitching details, welding and many more 'hidden' production intricacies and considerations are factored into production.

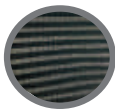
Furthermore, our team of expert machinists and production staff significantly contribute to the exceptionally high quality of products for which we are renowned.



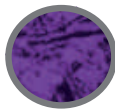
A variety of materials are used for sling construction: Soft-knit Polyester is strong, soft and durable. Parachute silk is ultrafine yet incredibly strong while 3D-Spacer moulds to body shape for extra comfort and support.



High grade slidesheet fabric is applied to key areas to assist with sling fitting and help reduce tissue viability risks.



Breathable fabrics allow air circulation aiding temperature control, being especially important for In-Chair slings.



Non-slip fabrics such as the luxurious one-way velvet velour is used for additional security benefits.



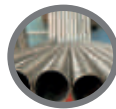
Laser-cutting technology is employed as standard, allowing precision cutting and clean lines for slings.



In bathing-related situations, it's important to have fast draining and quick drying materials that are also kind to the skin, which is why we don't use mesh fabric in any of our products.



Latex-free vinyl used in our BATHING RANGE is soft to the touch, hard-wearing, hygienic and protective against harmful bacteria.



Stainless steel used as framework for bathing products is robust, rust-resistant and can be further powder-coated.

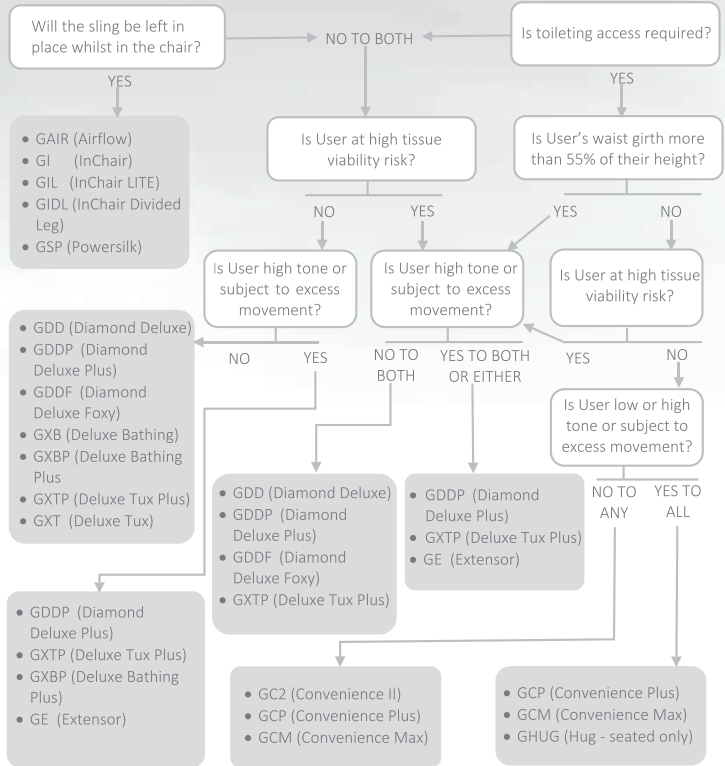
CHOOSING THE RIGHT SLING

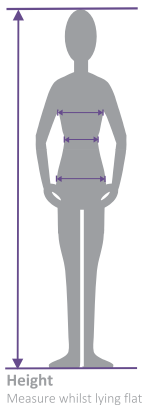

PRESSURE MAPPING

Pressure Mapping is a specialised measurement technology used to visualise the contact pressure distribution between the human body and a supporting surface and equipment interface, e.g. chair or sling. This is especially important for In-Chair style slings where the user remains in a seated position for longer than usual.

Care & Independence commission independent pressure mapping experts to conduct pressure mapping trials to ascertain sling performance and help identify areas of risk.

Unlike most others, we pressure map the actual sling, not just the fabric, meaning the subsequent scientific data insight has enabled Care & Independence to develop solutions and vastly improve upon the areas which indicate tissue viability risks, pain or other health concerns to the equipment user.

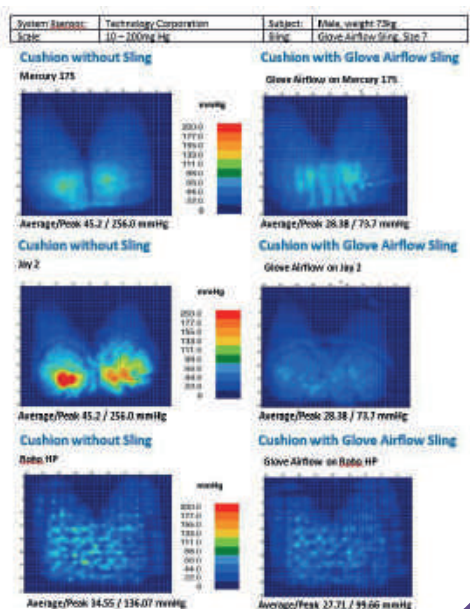
This is also why Care & Independence In-Chair slings do not incorporate an aperture in the design as this has been proven to be detrimental to a seated In-Chair sling user.

- Extra padding added to identified key-risk areas
- Improved temperature regulation
- Risk reduction to soft tissue damage
- Greater comfort via our patented seam-free leg sections

INGENIOUS SIMPLICITY - HOW IT WORKS

BURNETT REMOULD products comprise of a durable and watertight outer vinyl casing that houses thousands of soft beads*. Much like a beanbag, the concept involves the precise manipulation of the beads around exacting body contours, giving a moulded support as unique as the individual user.



Products are categorised as either vacuum-moulded or self-regulating:

VACUUM-MOULDED

All vacuum-moulded products work by using a pump to extract air from the product casing. This causes the support casing to become semi-firmed, allowing the thousands of internal beads to be manipulated into a bespoke shape for the user. Once the desired shape is moulded, further air extraction compacts the moulding into a set shape.

It is only with the reintroduction of air via the product valve that the product casing will return to a malleable state ready for re-moulding.



Air is vacuumed out allowing beads to be manipulated and set into a bespoke moulded support.

SELF-REGULATING

For self-regulating products, no pump is required. Instead as weight is applied to the product, air is naturally expelled into a hollow chamber flap at the extremity of the product casing, allowing the beads to mould into a supportive shape according to the weight distribution. As the product warms up e.g. through body heat transfer or bath water, so the product becomes more pliable.

When weight is alleviated, the air returns to the main casing and the moulding disperses, ready for re-use.



With applied weight, air is dispersed leaving compacted beads to form the moulded shape.
